**Natural Christmas trees under 6ft** can be collected. If you pay for garden waste collections you can put them out on normal garden waste collection days for composting. Otherwise, take to Recycling Centre or put out the tree on your normal refuse collection day between 9 and 20 January 2012 for disposal. Place the tree next to your bin or sack. **Remove all decorations.**
